Dear Mr. Butz,

This is in response for your request received 12 March 2007 (RSA Number: 47818) concerning the citations of the Presidential Unit Awards and the Air Force Outstanding Unit Awards with Combat "V" Device, and the Republic of Vietnam Cross of Gallantry Unit Award for the 12th Tactical Reconnaissance Squadron. Since your request was made under provisions of the Freedom of Information Act, it has been designated 07-048.

Our repository is composed of official unit histories. Unfortunately, we only have what the unit historian sent to us at the time the historian submitted their history. In this case, all that I could find was the citation for the Presidential Unit Citation (PUC) for the 12th Tactical Reconnaissance Squadron's parent unit (the 460th Tactical Reconnaissance Wing) for the 18 February 1966 through 30 June 1967 time frame. The 12th Tactical Reconnaissance Squadron did not join the 460th Wing until 9 September 1966, therefore, they only shared this particular PUC for the 9 September 1966 through 30 June 1967 period. Subsequent awards of the PUC were not even mentioned in either the official histories of the 460th Wing or the 12th Tactical Reconnaissance Squadron. The 12th Tactical Reconnaissance Squadron transferred to the 67th Tactical Reconnaissance Wing on 1 September 1971, after the 460th Wing inactivated on 31 August 1971; therefore the squadron did not receive copies of any award citations bestowed upon the 406th Wing for its accomplishments prior to 1 September 1971. I have enclosed all of the orders for each of the awards you requested, but I could not find any citations for them. Either the local unit did not receive a copy to be submitted along with their history, or, the unit had already been inactivated and therefore did not submit any histories that would have included the citation at the time of the order. For instance, the 460th Wing's order for its PUC for the 1 February through 31 March 1971 was not published until 10 April 1972, almost seven months after the 460th Wing had been inactivated.

If you interpret this "no records" response as an adverse action, you may appeal this decision, and write to the Secretary of the Air Force within 60 calendar days from the date of this letter. You need to include in the appeal your reasons for reconsideration, attach a copy of this letter, and address your letter as follows:
